This document provides instructions on the format of the final research paper. Please follow these instructions. Deviate from them at your peril.

Recall that the paper should be ten to twelve pages in length. This does not include your cover page or references. An abstract is not required. If included, the abstract does not count toward the page length. Long papers will not be penalized so long as they are under, say, 20 pages and are not *unnecessarily* long. (Don't go into too much detail or off on tangents) Short papers will be.

Please include a cover page. It should include the title of paper, your name, the course, and date.

- Pagination: Double spaced. Double spaced (not quadruple spaced) also between paragraphs. Please number your pages. Please use black ink and white 8.5 by 11 inch paper. Subheadings are fine.
- Margins: One-inch margins on all sides (top, bottom, left, right).
- Font: 12-point Times New Roman or 11.5-point Arial
- Please staple your paper in the upper LEFT corner BEFORE you turn it in
- Citation: APSA method.
